

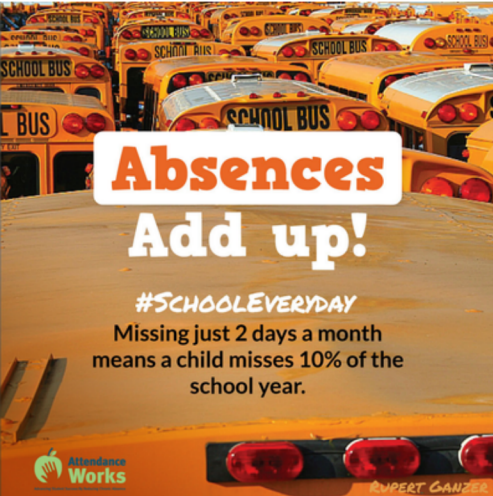

Federal Impact Aid Forms

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

- The Federal Impact Aid Program is designed to compensate local school districts for revenue lost due to the presence of federally owned, and therefore tax-exempt property.
- The amount of aid provided to schools is based on the number of students with parents/guardians that
 - **1) Are active military service members**
 - **2) Reside on federal property**
 - **3) Work on federal property**
- Impact Aid dollars help provide instructional materials, equipment, staff, special education programming, building improvements, busing and more!
- **Takes only a few minutes to complete and sign! Watch for notices from your school coming in October**



TIPS for PARENTS

- Before you go:
 - Review your child's assignments & assessments
 - Make a list of questions/concerns
- During the Conference:
 - Ask questions and share information (interests, concerns, strengths and struggles)
 - Get contact information and teacher's preferred method of communication

This non-medical counseling is designed to address issues that occur across the military lifestyle and help Service members and their families cope with the normal reactions to stressful/adverse situations created by deployments and reintegration. The MFLC Program utilizes professional, licensed and credentialed counselor to support and augment installation Child and Youth Programs, DoDEA schools, local education agencies, DoDEA/CYP summer programs, national Military Family Association Operation Purple Camps, Guard/Reserve Camps and OMK Camps.

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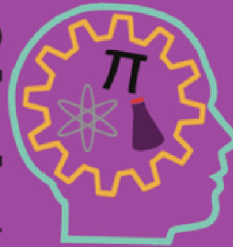
